GENDERQUEER

SIMILAR TO NON-BINARY; SO,E FIND THE TERM "QUEER" OFFENSIVE, WHILE OTHERS EMBRACE IT

NON-BINARY

THAT ARE NOT EXCLUSIVELY

MASCULINE OR FEMININE

A SOCIAL AND LEGAL STATUS AND **EXPECTATIONS FROM SOCIETY ABOUT A PERSON'S BEHAVIORS,** CHARACTERISTICS, AND THOUGHTS. **INDIVIDUALS INTERNAL** PERCEPTIONS MAY NOT ALIGN WITH **EXTERNAL CATEGORIES**



GENDERFLUID

REFERS TO A PERSON WHOSE GENDER IDENTITY CHANGES OVER

TIME OR AT DIFFERENT TIMES



CISGENDER VS. TRANSGENDER

CISGENDER REFERS TO SOMEONE WHOSE GENDER MATCHES THE SEC **ASSIGNED TO THEM AT BIRTH, WHILE TRANSGENDER REFERS TO A PERSON** WHOSE GENDER DOES NOT MATCH THE SEX ASSIGNED TO THEM AT BIRTH
